Construction of upgrades and improvements to the Biddle Point sewer lift station were financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund.

The CWSRF program is administered by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great

This project will replace all pumps, motors, controls, ventilation, safety and power generation equipment and will provide sewer pumping reliability for community residents and businesses on Mackinac Island.
